A reminder that the school office will no longer be accepting any cash dinner money.

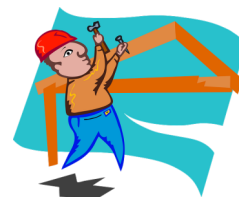
Parents will now need to pay any dinner money bills via ParentPay.
