The money raised at the KS2 concert will support our performing arts programme—thank you for your generosity.

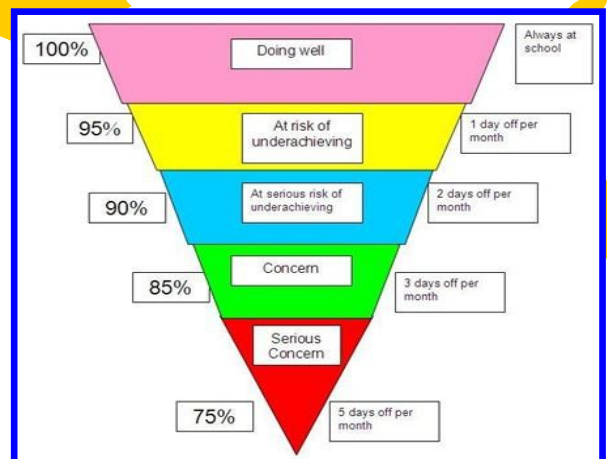
