Despite the spring term being a very short one, we still have many exciting learning opportunities planned including Healthy Living Week, St. David's Day and World Book Day.

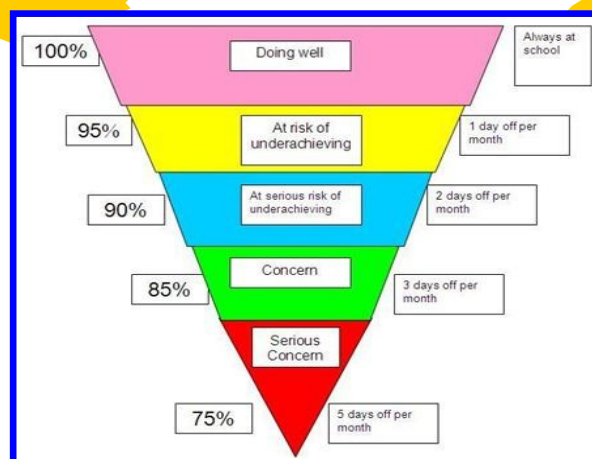
