Due to parent consultations, there will be no school run clubs next week.

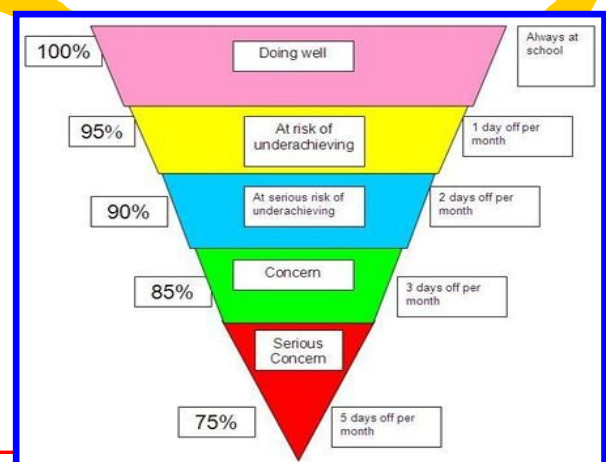
