We have had many wonderful events on this term and, on behalf of the staff, I would like to thank you for your continued support.

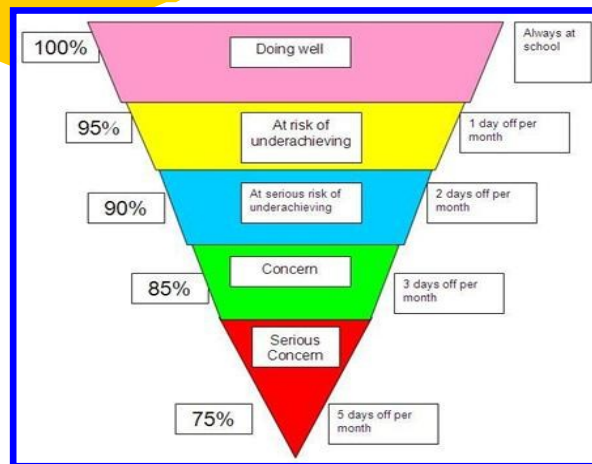

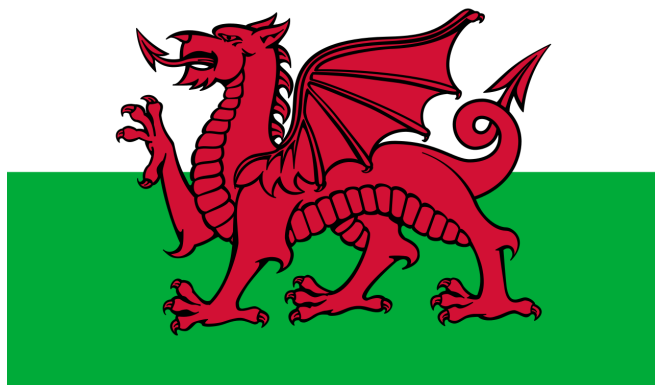
