I would also like to take this opportunity to thank the staff, parents and children for making me feel so welcome and for making my first year a year filled with wonderful memories.

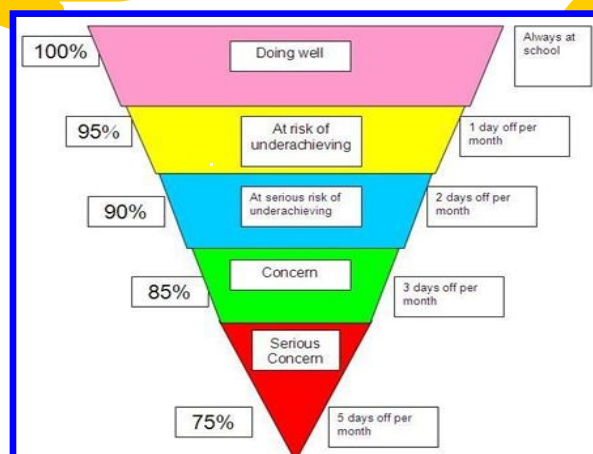
I wish you all a happy and relaxed summer holiday and look forward to welcoming you back on Monday 5th September.
