Next week sees the start of our Christmas Concerts. We look forward to welcoming you to our performances in order to celebrate the start of the Christmas festivities.

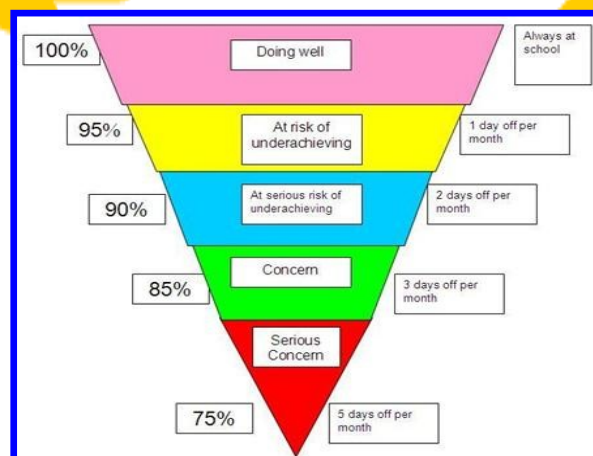

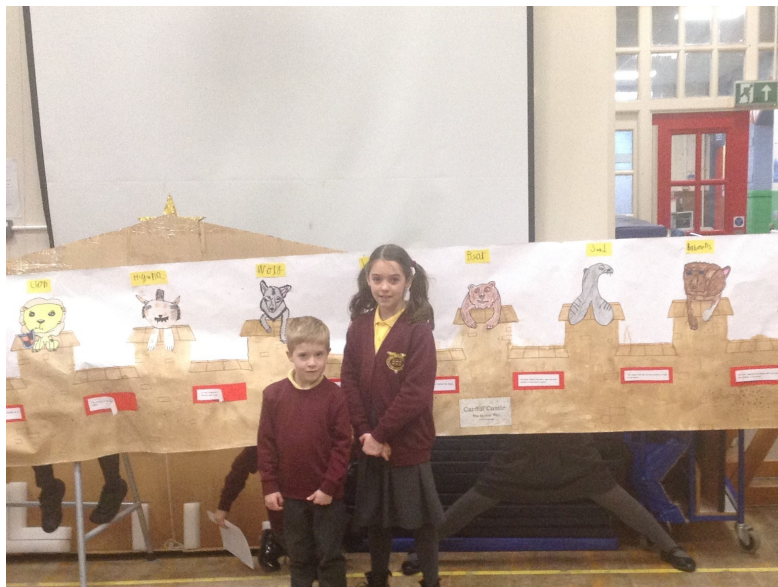
