Friday 20th December will be a normal school day, with all children back in school uniform.

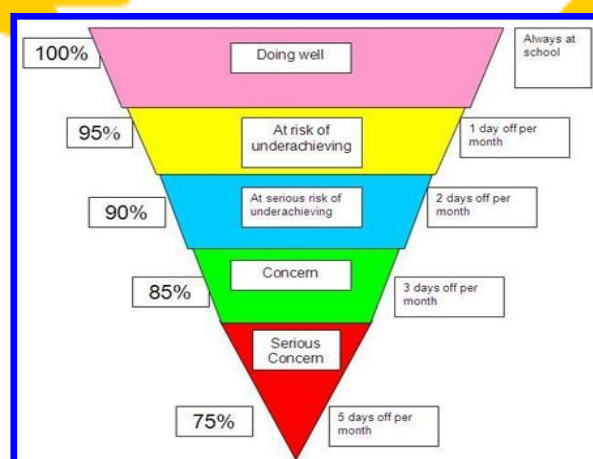

School attendance for this week was 94%. A special well done to Classes 2Sw and 4WH who had the highest attendance with 97.8%. WELL DONE!

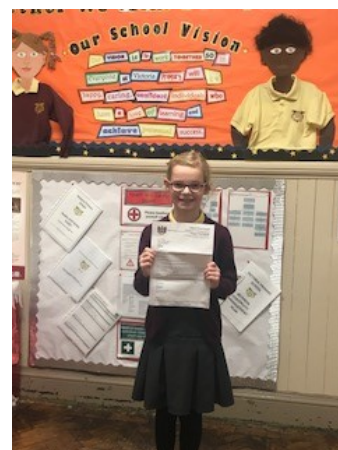


Town Mayor Christmas Competition Results

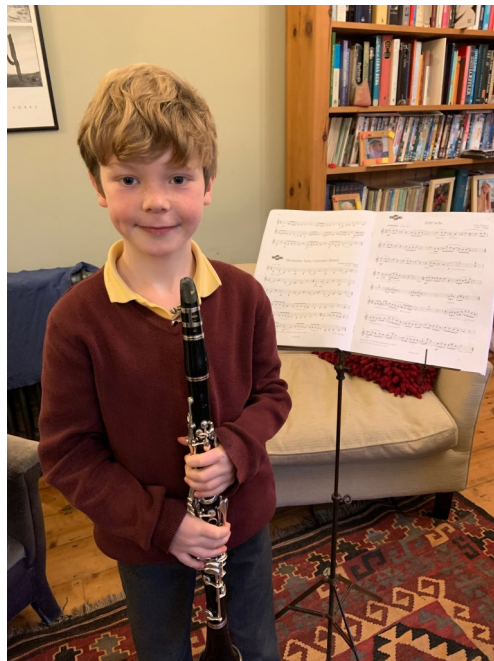


Musical Achievements
