Finally, a reminder that Parent/teacher meetings will be taking place this week. If you cannot make this very important meeting, then please contact the class-teacher to organise an alternative date.

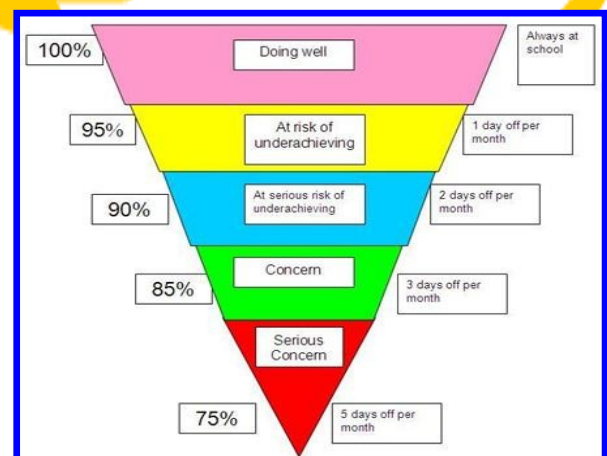
