However, due to their resilience and great tem spirit, I believe that all of our children are winners. I am very proud of them!

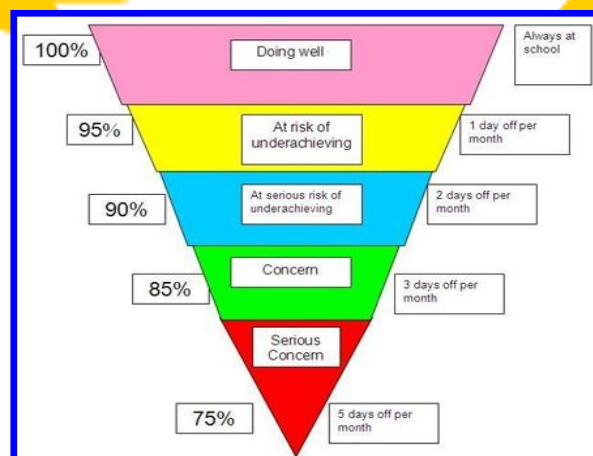
