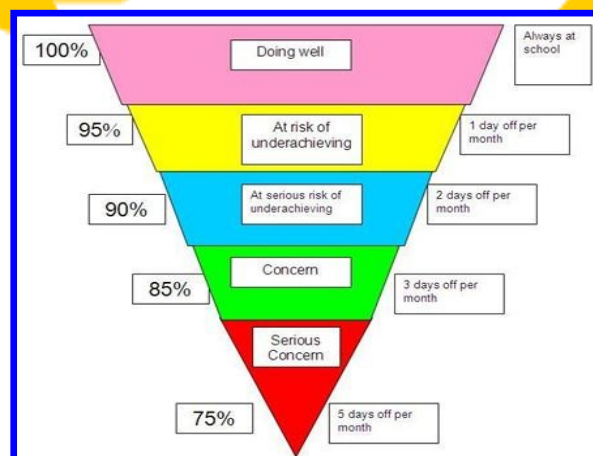

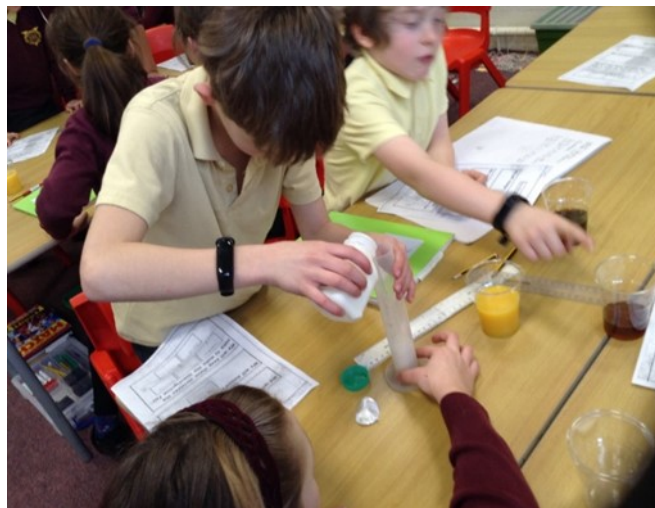

Super Scientists in Year 4

Children in Mr Husband and Mrs Frayne's class investigated the effects of different liquids on our teeth. The class used orange juice, milk, vinegar, coca cola and water. The children made predication based on what they already knew about the liquids. Egg shells were used to replicate the effects of the liquids on teeth. The children set up the investigation so that it was fair. During the Science lessons they used their literacy and numeracy skills effectively e.g. measuring the volume of liquids using measuring cylinders. They made careful observations of changes to the egg shells over time and discovered that vinegar has the most effect on teeth



Yoga in Reception

Last Friday, both Reception classes began a yoga programme which will last six weeks. The children were able to practice relaxation techniques and the teachers were made aware of strategies that they could apply in the classroom.

Sarah, our Yoga instructor, was very complimentary about that school and children and is looking forward to working with Reception over the coming weeks.
