Obviously, we have some areas to improve on and you will be able to see the full analysis on the school website shortly.

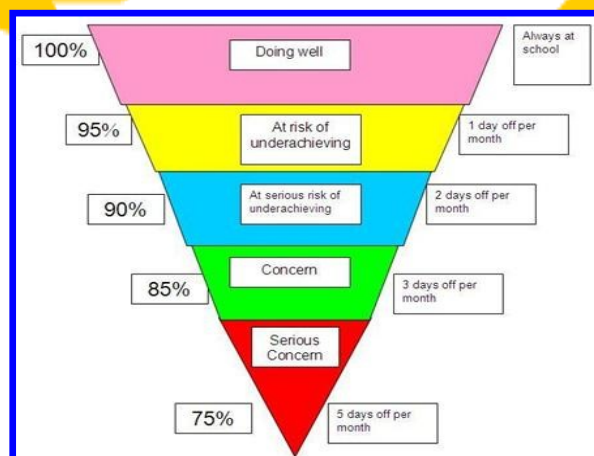
