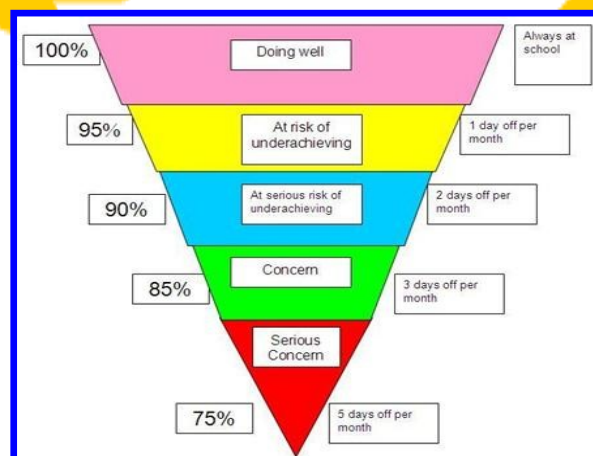
Have a lovely holiday and we look forward to welcoming the children back on **Tuesday 8th January 2018**.
