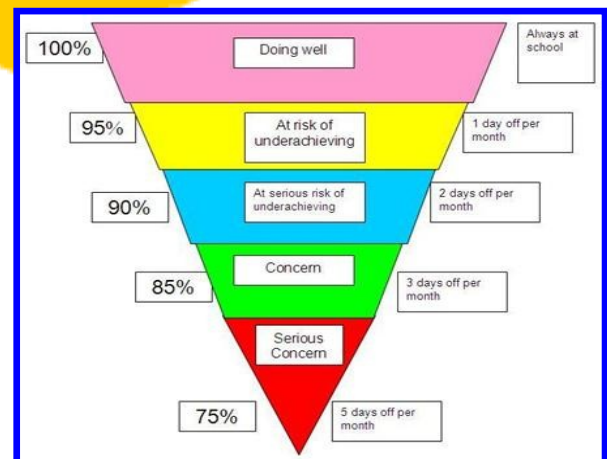

Christmas Fayre

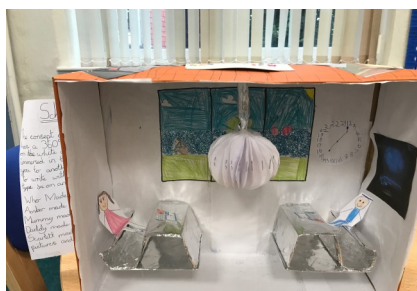
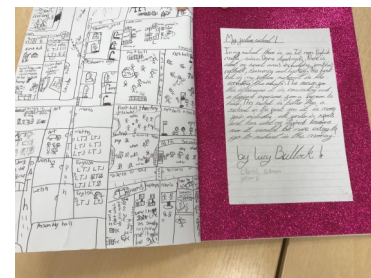
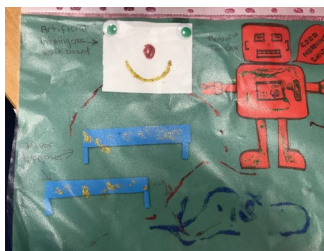
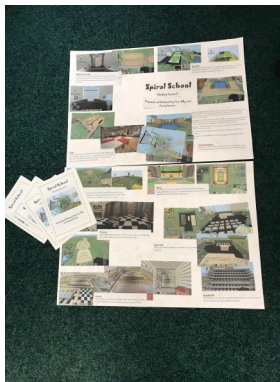
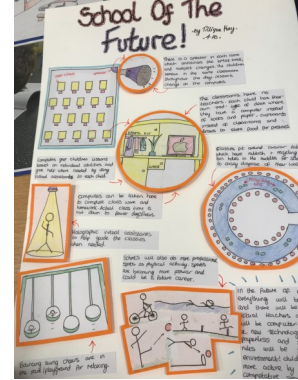
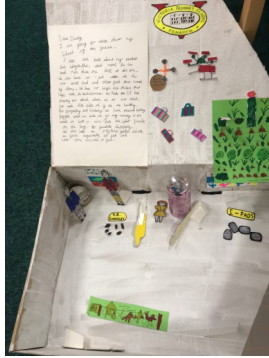
