A huge well done to all the staff and children who remembered their odd socks on Monday. A wonderful opportunity for us to celebrate difference.



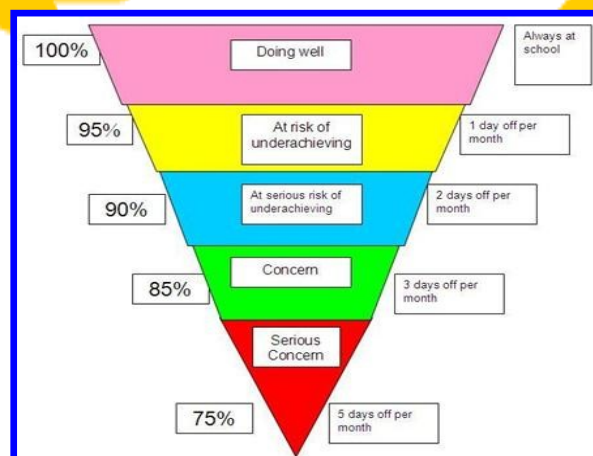

Home for a Hedgehog

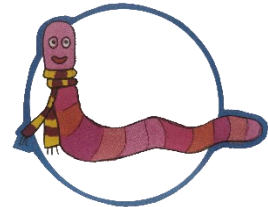
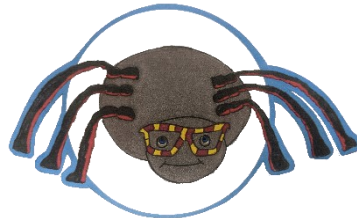
Last weekend Ellie and Izzy Weigel, with the help of Julia Wells and Emma Slugg, made and installed a hedgehog house in Victoria playing fields.
