- The week beginning **Monday 6th December**, the children will start filming their class Christmas productions, which will be available for all parents to view on **Monday 13th December**.

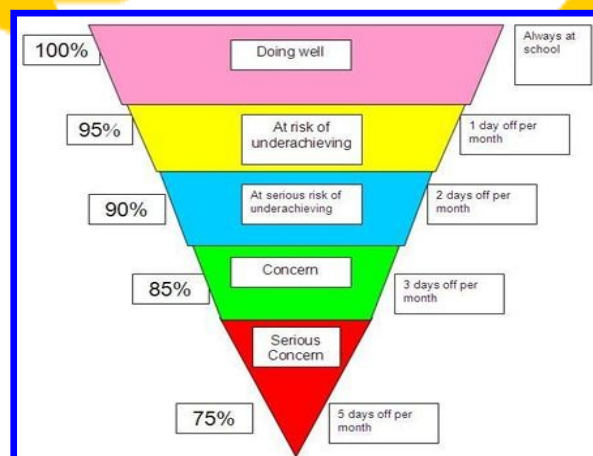

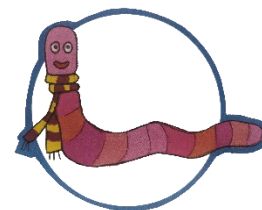
