Thank you to all of the parents who have donated food for the Food pod. The final date for donations will be Tuesday 14th December.

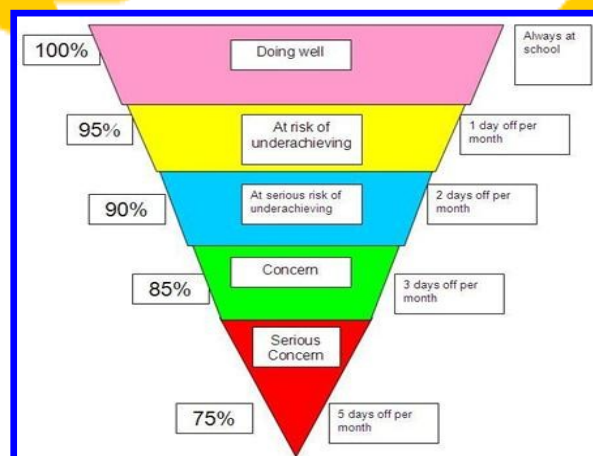

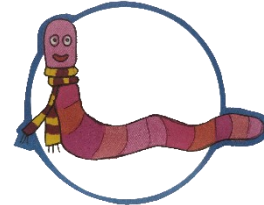
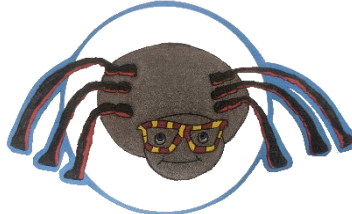


Year 1 and Year 2 Theatre Trip
