On Wednesday, the children sang with the Salvation Army band. What a wonderful experience for us all; the recording will be included as our finale to the online Christmas concert.

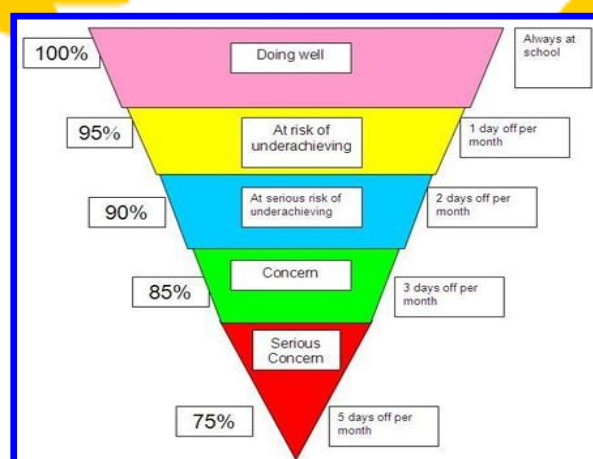

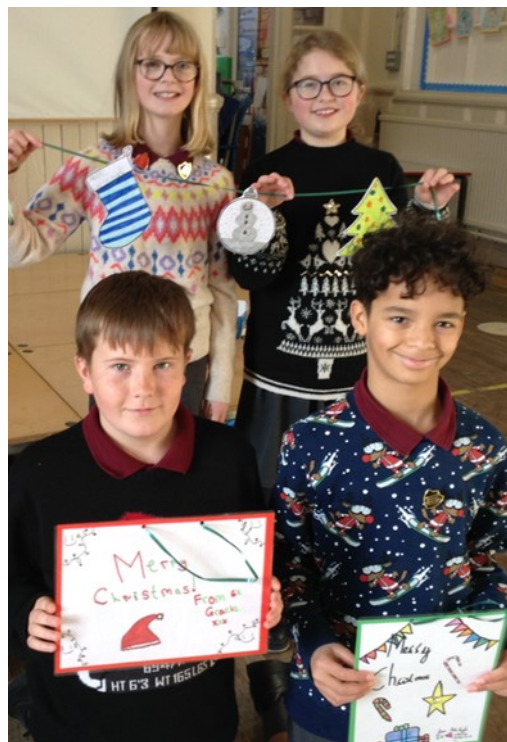

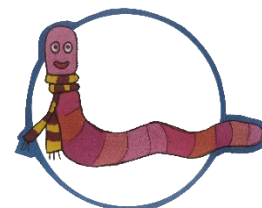


Year 5 Eco Decorations
