Our current risk assessment can be found on the website and I will inform you of any additional changes that happen as a result of Government updates.

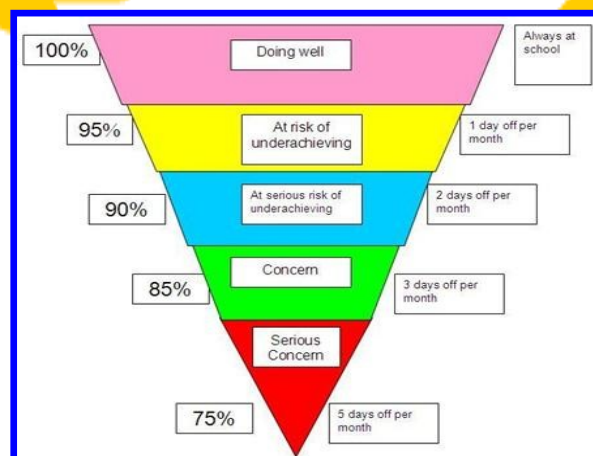
