Well done children!

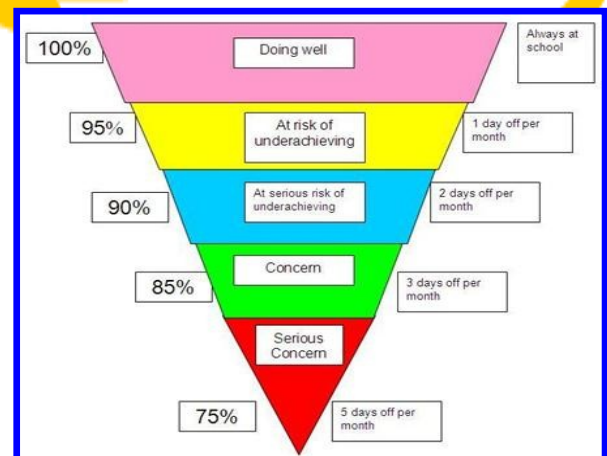
