Dear Parents,

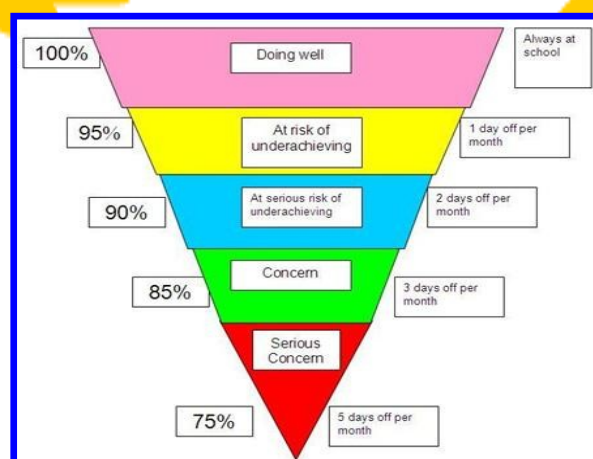

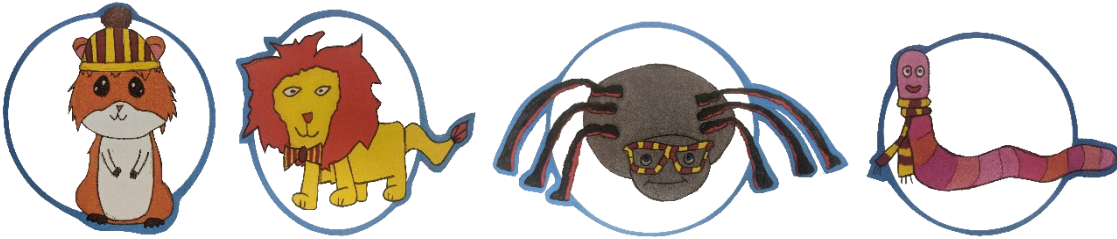

The Four Purposes in action



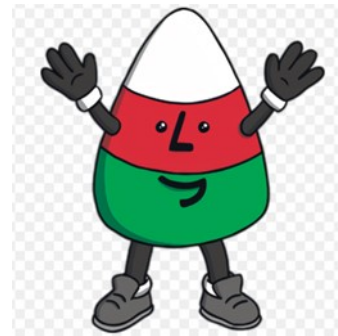
Our children never cease to amaze me and this week has been no different. Members of Y5 and Y6 have demonstrated all four purposes this week.

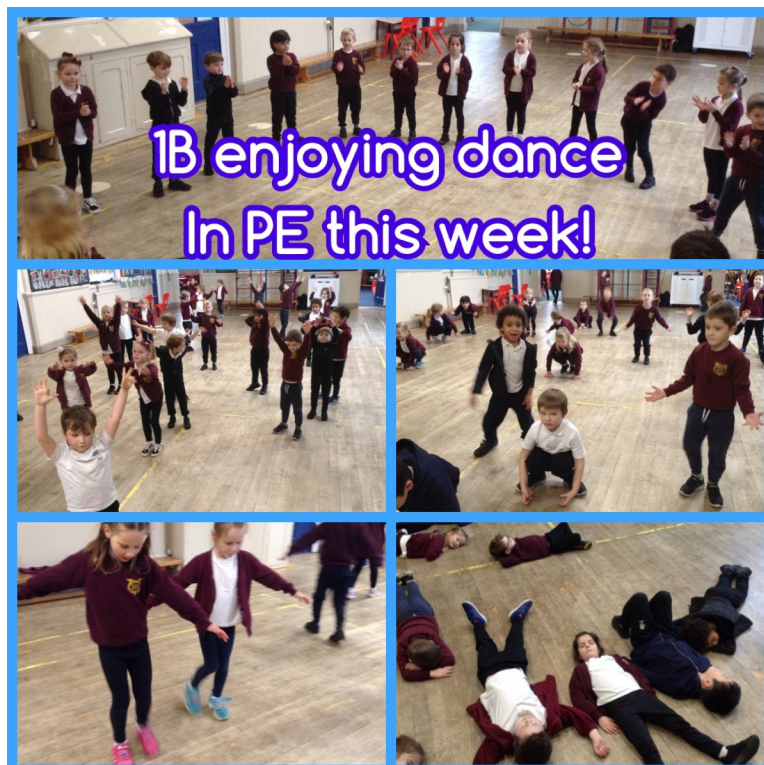
