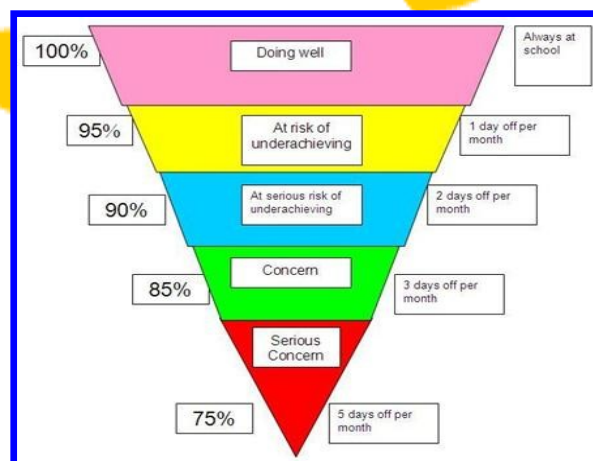

Eisteddfod

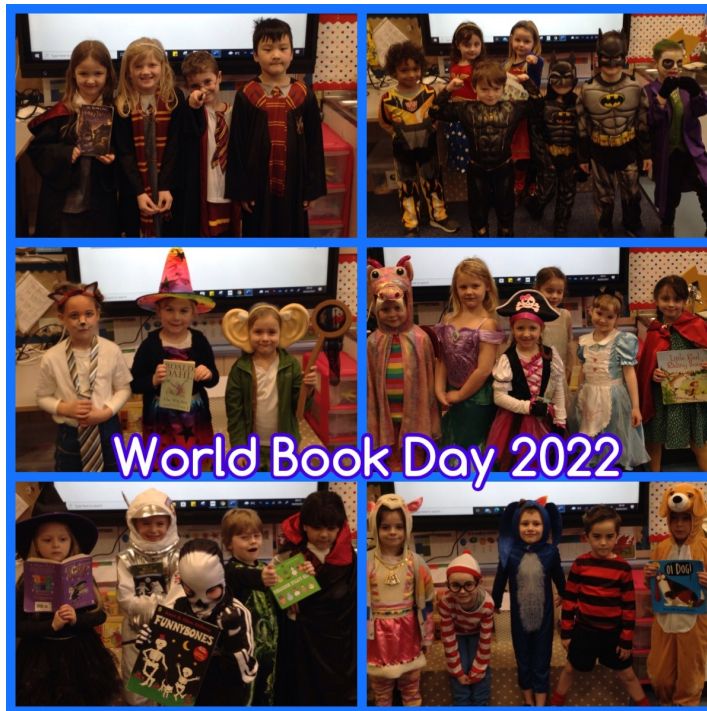
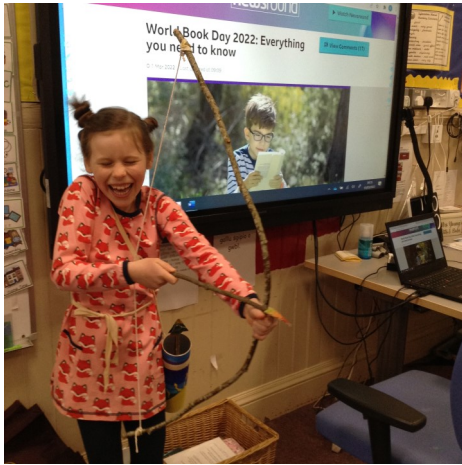
