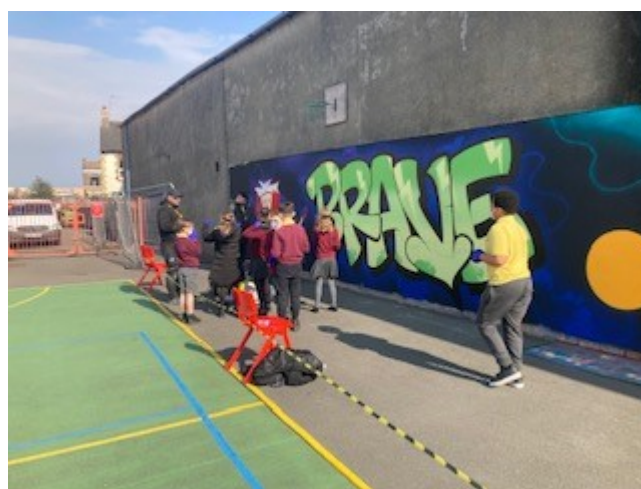
Busking to Raise Awareness
