As the weather does improve, please send your child to school with a water bottle and hat and ensure that suncream has been applied.

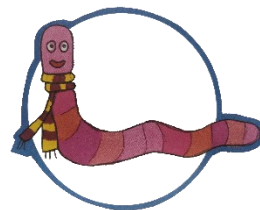
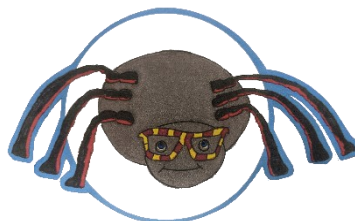
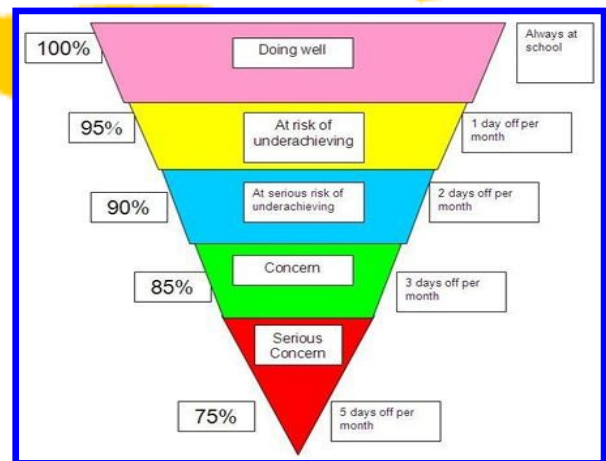

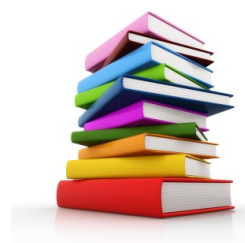
VICTORIA HELPING HAND FUNDRAISER
