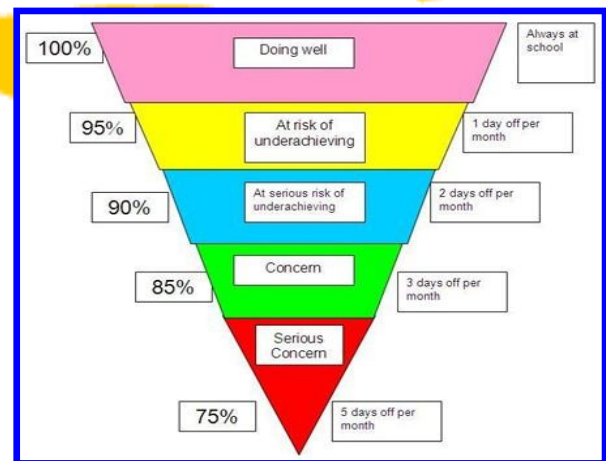

Year 5 Farmer's Market Update

Thank you to all of you who supported our microgreen farmer's market back in March. We raised £120 and we have steadily been investing the profits to enable us to grow more produce. The nursery garden area has undergone some major improvements over the last few months, and this means that our raised beds were ready for planting in. Prior to the Easter

holidays, we planted seeds in propagators, and these have now been moved to the raised beds. We will be keeping regular checks on them, and we hope to harvest these to sell for voluntary donations – we will update you when they are ready. In the meantime, we will be having another 'Farmer's Market' on **Tuesday 17th May** after school under the shelter. This time we will be selling hand-made bath bombs which have been packaged sustainably. The children have gained so much from these hands-on projects which have enabled them to acquire lifelong entrepreneurial skills, and to consider how making your own produce can positively affect the environment.



Sharing our learning Journey

On Monday 23rd May, the children would like to share their learning journals with you. As I explained in the curriculum information meetings, this year the children have had one learning journal to record their learning journey and they are very proud of the content. Each child's learning journal is different as it is personal to them.

On the day, please come to school at your allotted time, using the lane gate only. You will then spend 20 minutes with your child/ children (if they are in the same year group) sharing their journals. Time is limited as we have to ensure that every year group has an opportunity to share. At the end of the session, please leave promptly through the emergency exit gate.

If you cannot make the time, then please feel welcome to send another family member instead (grandparents, aunts or uncles).

We look forward to seeing you and sharing our learning from this year.
