Monday, is an opportunity for the children to share their learning with you. We hope to see many of you on the yard at your allotted time.

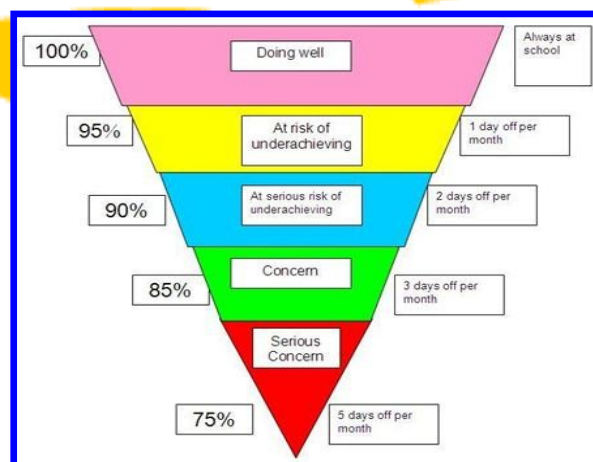

Below is a pictorial reminder to parents on how important it is for children to attend school everyday. We would like to thank you for your continued support in this area.

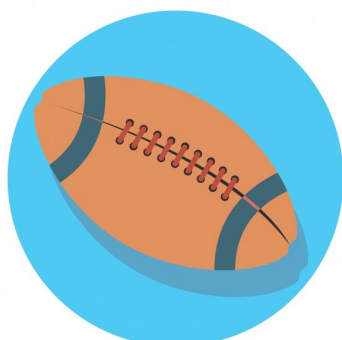
School attendance for this week was 94%. A special well done to Class 4S who had the highest attendance with 98%. WELL DONE!

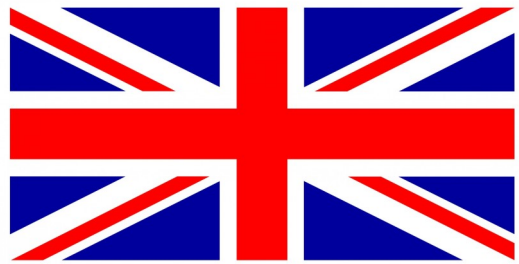
Jubilee Celebrations
