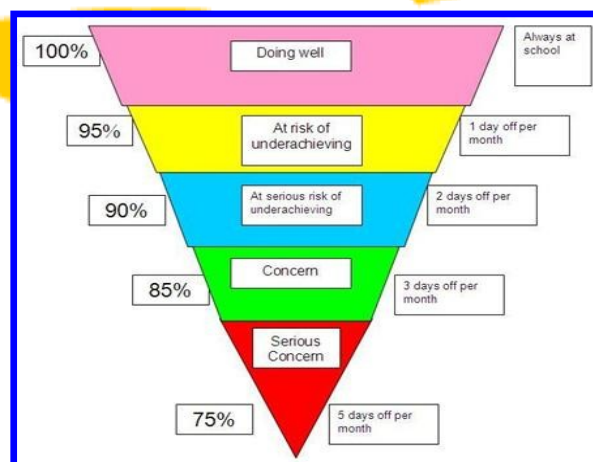
Have a lovely week and we look forward to welcoming the children back on **Monday 6th June**.

School attendance for this week was 93%. A special well done to Class 1B who had the highest attendance with 99%. **WELL DONE!**



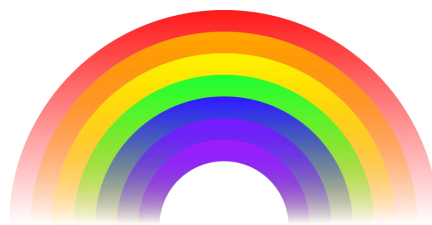
### Rainbow Room

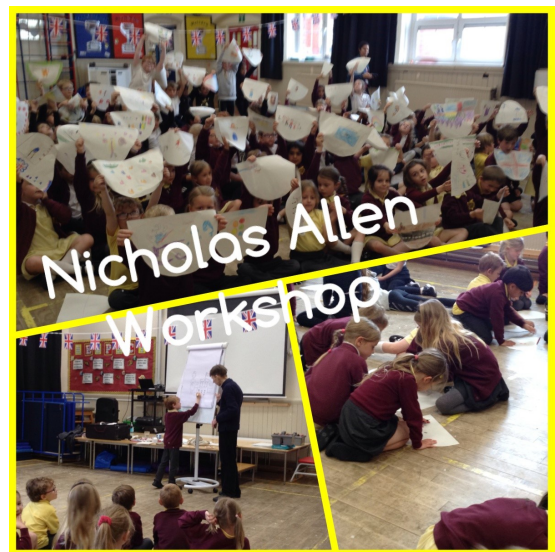


## Jubilee Celebrations

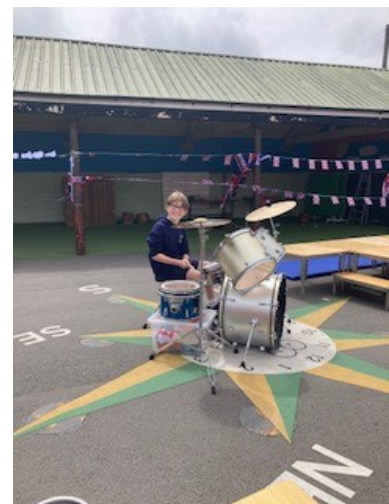
Today, we hosted our very own Jubilee street party and were able to have lunch together as a whole school.
