We hope to see you at the annual Summer Fayre tomorrow—fingers crossed for sunny weather!

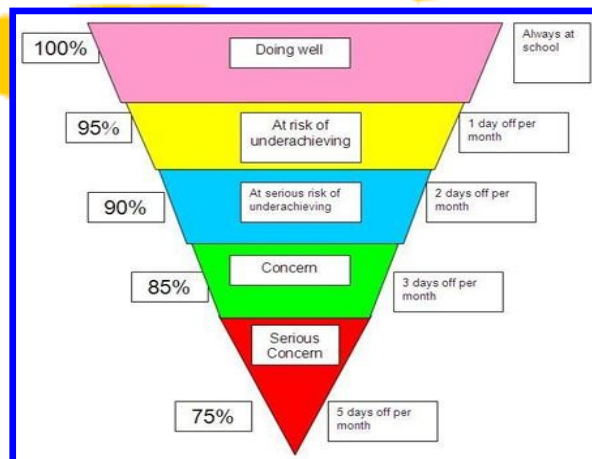

Year 5 And Friends of Victoria Square Gardens

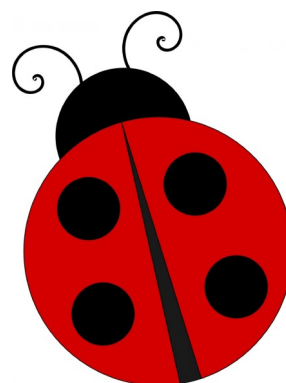
