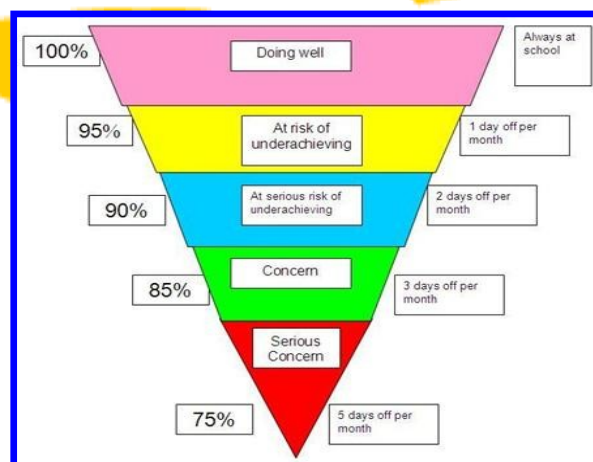
The temperatures are certainly increasing, so please ensure that your child comes to school with a sunhat and water. Sun cream should be applied before the school day starts. Thank you for your support.

Welsh Government Personalised Assessments (Yr2-6)



The children in years 2-6 have been working hard on their personalised assessments in Maths and Reading during the past few weeks. There were two Maths tests and one Reading test. The 'Procedural', which measures number, measuring and data handling skills and 'Reasoning' which looks at how well the children can apply their maths skills to solve everyday problems. The Reading test was made up of short questions based on two or more texts and looks at how well the texts have been understood.

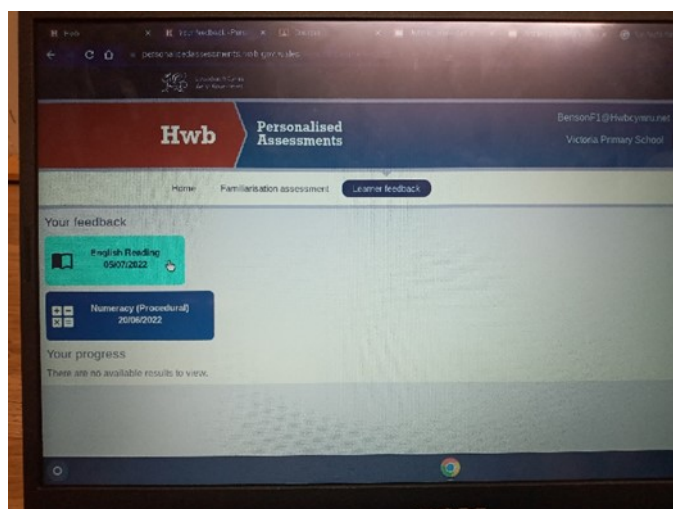
The children completed these tests via their hwb account using a laptop. The tests are designed to react to the ability of the child; if they are unable to answer a question or answer incorrectly the computer will adjust the next questions accordingly.

You will now be able to see the areas within maths and reading that your child might need support with. It would be a good idea to do this with your child so that they can see this information with you. To view this feedback please follow the instructions below.

Ask your child to log into their hwb account using their username and password

Click on to 'Personalised Assessments' and then 'Learner feedback'

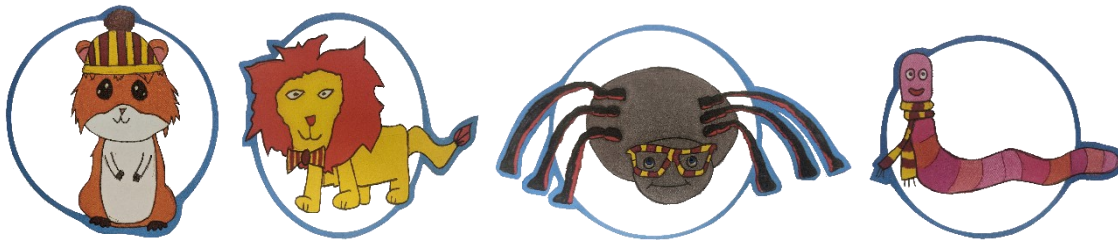
After following these instructions you should see the screen below. Click on the tabs to view feedback. If you have any problems please do not hesitate to contact your child's class teacher.

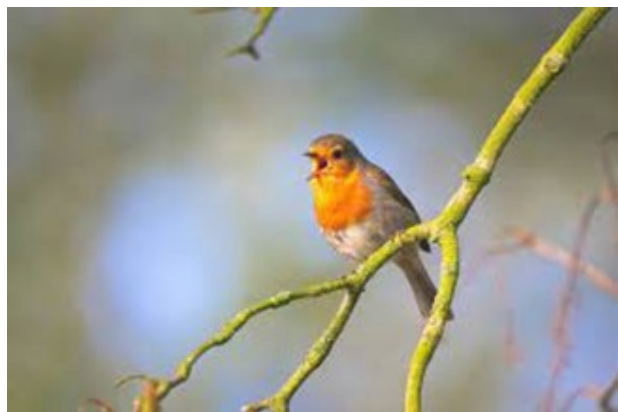




The Four Purposes Family challenge
