I wish you all a happy and relaxed summer holiday and look forward to welcoming you back on **Tuesday 6th September**.

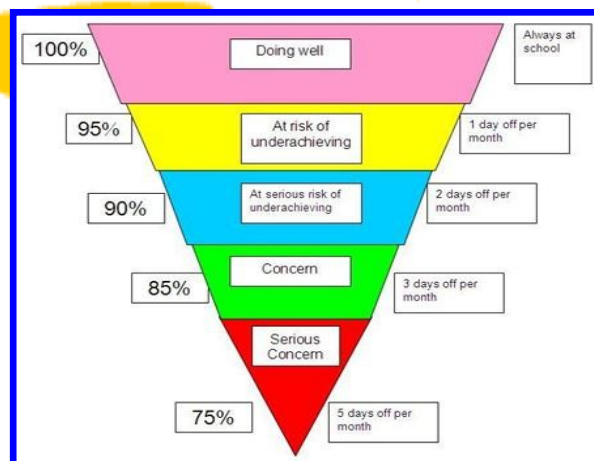
