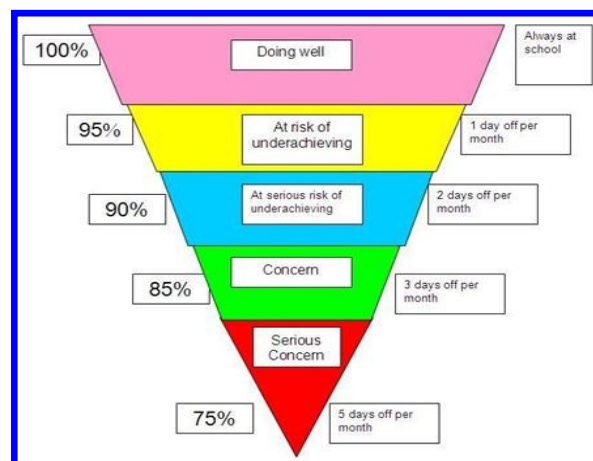

As the weather is so changeable at the moment, please ensure that your child comes to school with a waterproof jacket. Thank you.

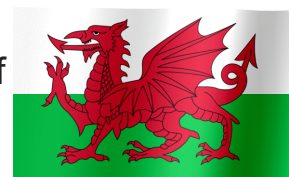


Miwsig Y Siarter Iaith
