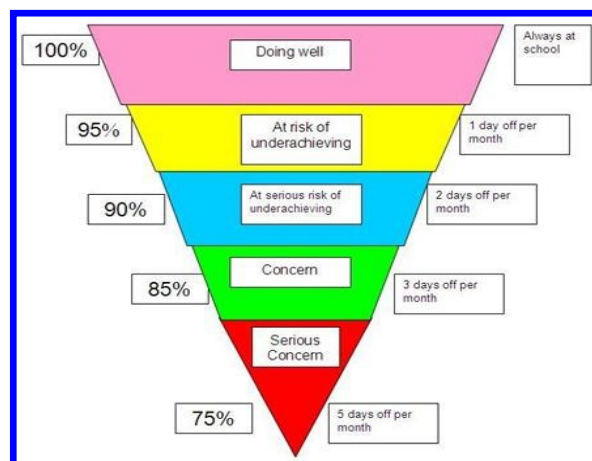

Temporary position in Breakfast Club

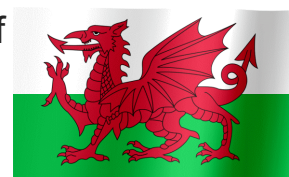
