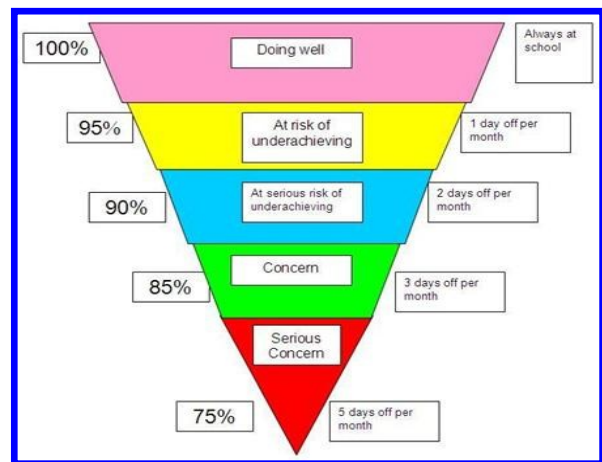

Child collection & release from school (taken from school Safeguarding policy)

As schools we need to understand the demands of parenting, along with the individual needs of our pupils.

It is essential to:

- Ask parents/carers to provide a list of people allowed to pick up their child in writing at the start of the academic year. **Never** let anyone who's not listed as authorised collect a pupil without contacting the parents/carer to verify their identity first.
- Ask parents to ensure contact sheets are updated to include the list of authorised people.
- Ask parents/ carers to inform school in advance of any changes to their collection arrangements (such as medical appointments)
- Make sure the teacher and office staff know if a pupil's going to be collected during the day, and who's collecting them.
- Encourage authorised adults to briefly introduce themselves to staff.

Pupils in Year 6 are able to walk home alone.

Temporary position in Breakfast Club

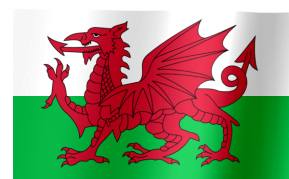
We are looking for temporary/supply breakfast club staff to work between 8am and 9am each day. Please contact the office if you are interested in the post.
