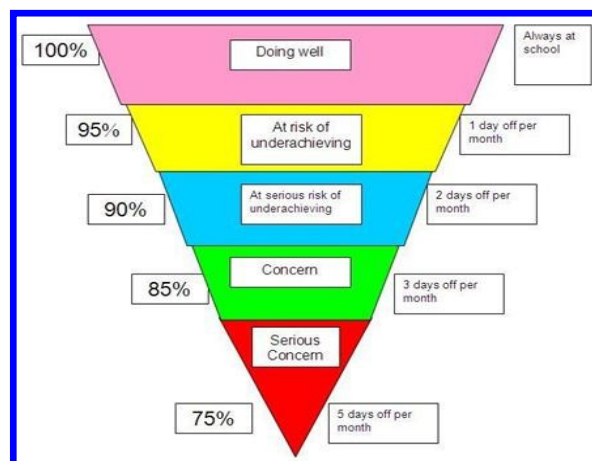
HEADTEACHER'S THOUGHTS THIS WEEK

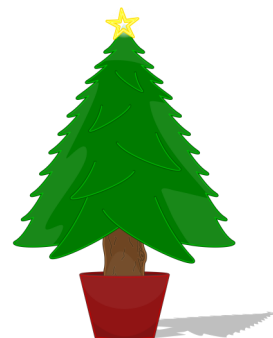
