We look forward to working with you again in ensuring that your children have another happy and successful term.

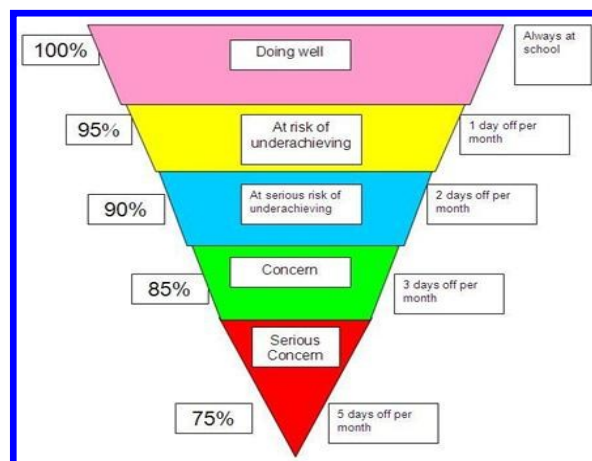
