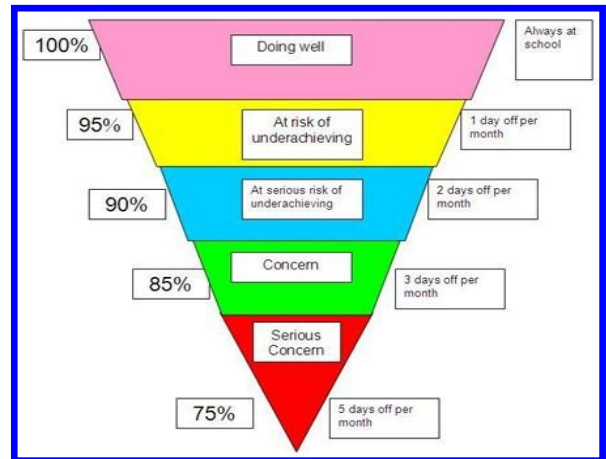
HEADTEACHER'S THOUGHTS THIS WEEK

Year 2 fire service visit

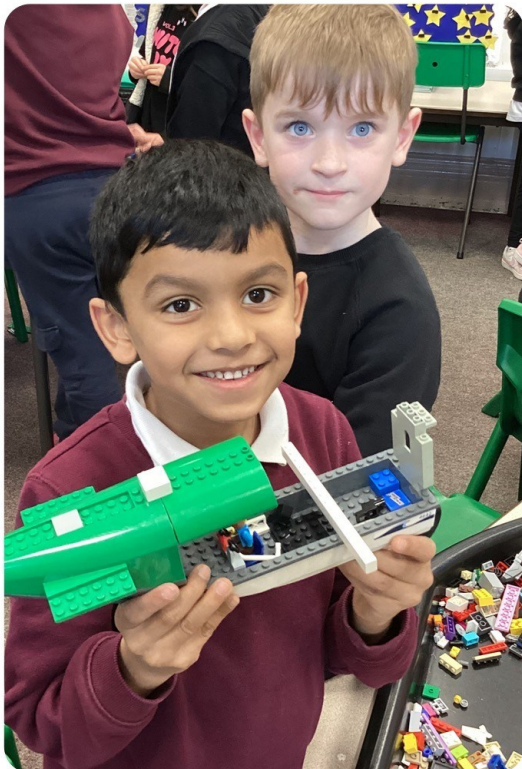
