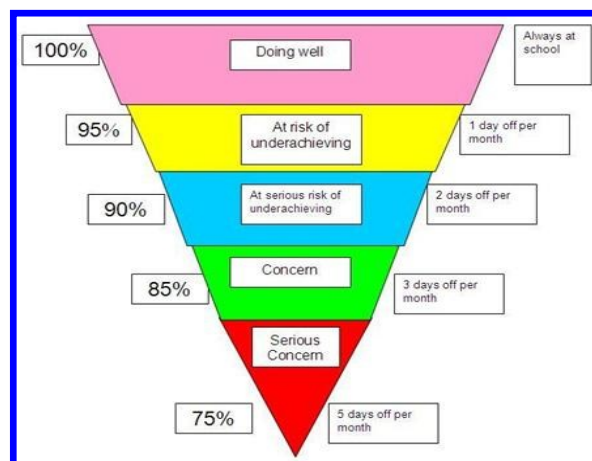

Foundation Phase - All children may dress up in Welsh costume

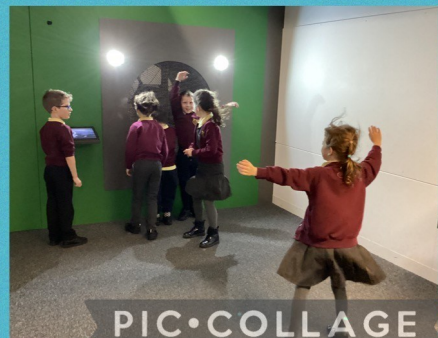

Year 1 and Year 2 had a wonderful trip to Technquest this week. A huge thank you to our parent volunteers—the trip would not have been possible without you.



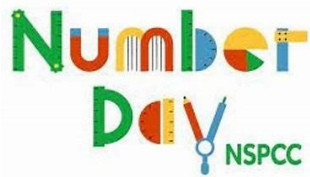
