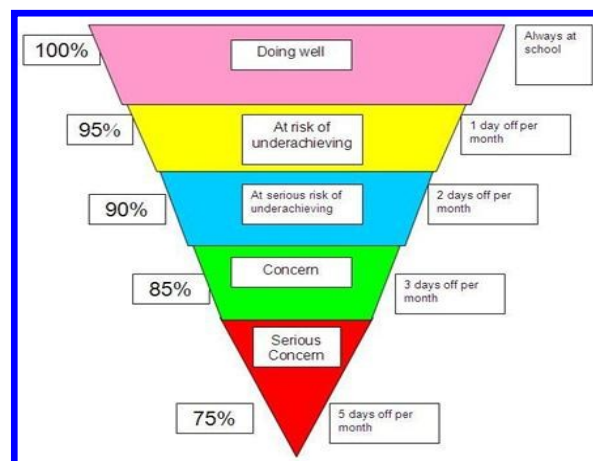

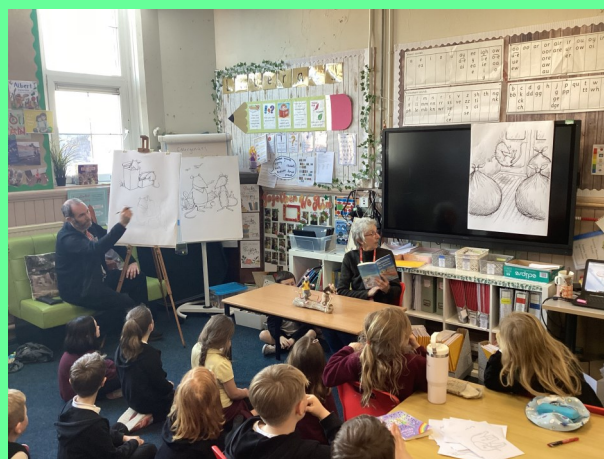
Stanwell Music Concert
