This coming week, the weather promises to further improve with some much needed sunshine. Please ensure that the children come to school with their water bottles. We will encourage them to fill up throughout the day.

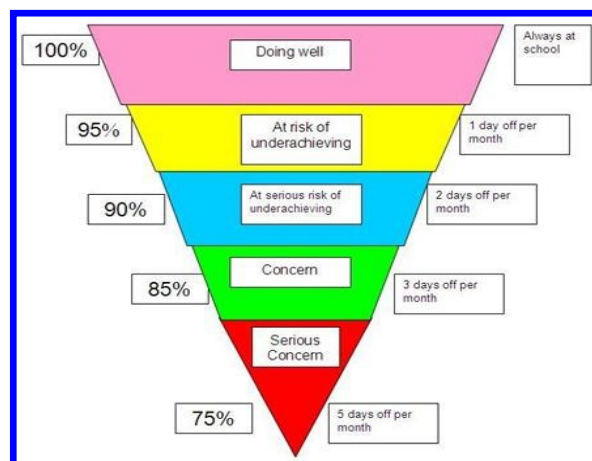

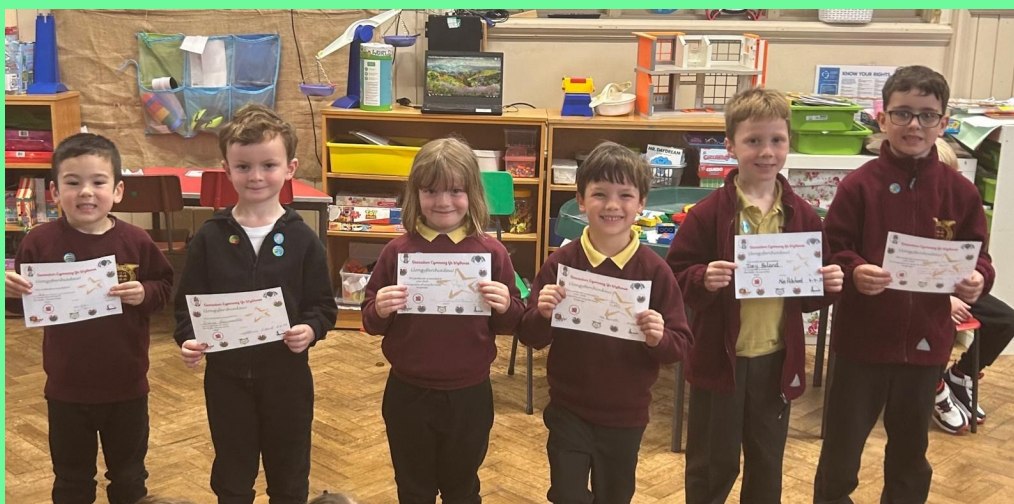

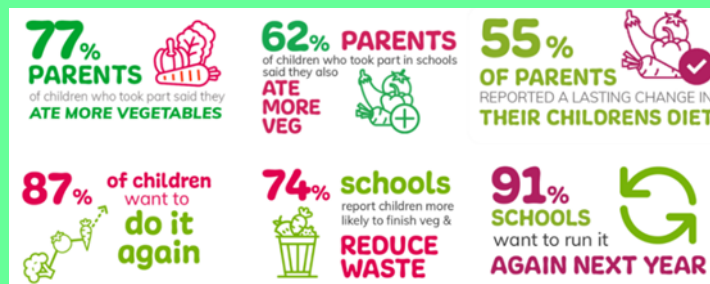
