HEADTEACHER'S THOUGHTS THIS WEEK

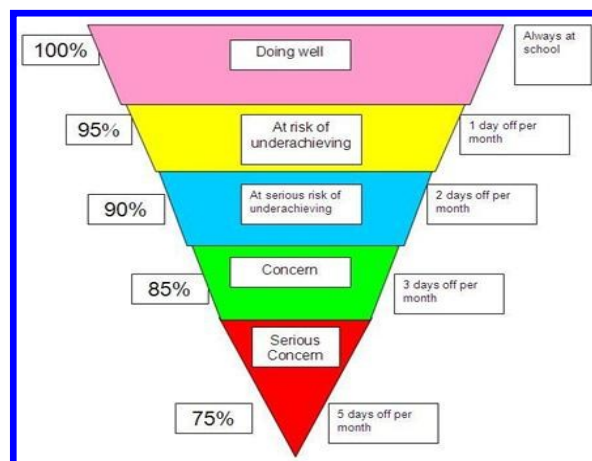
Annwyl Parents/carers,

Easter E-Safety Competition

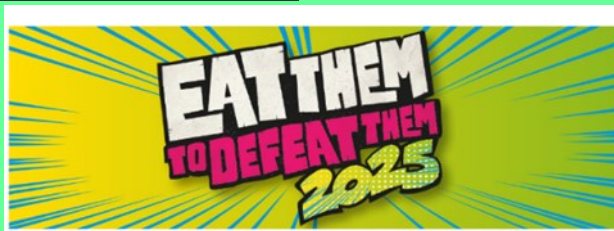

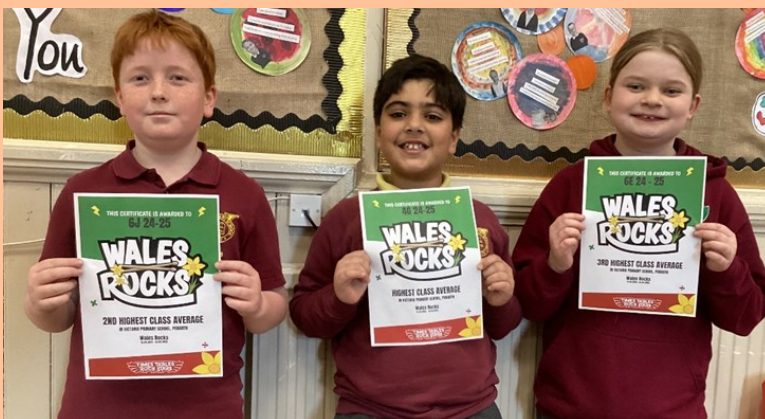
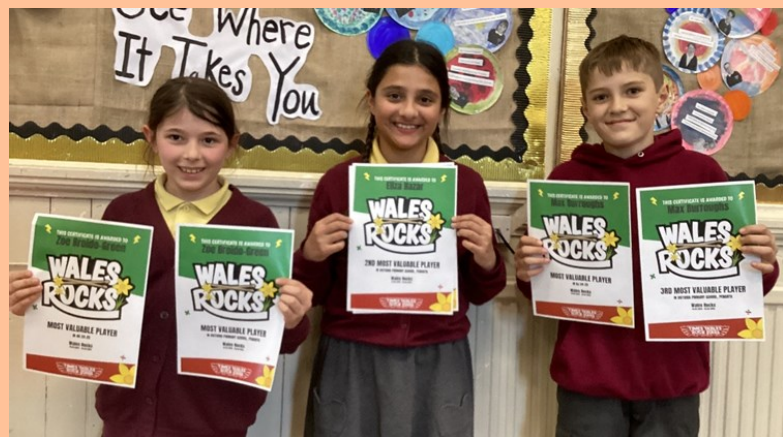
