Well done Victoria; this is brilliant news!

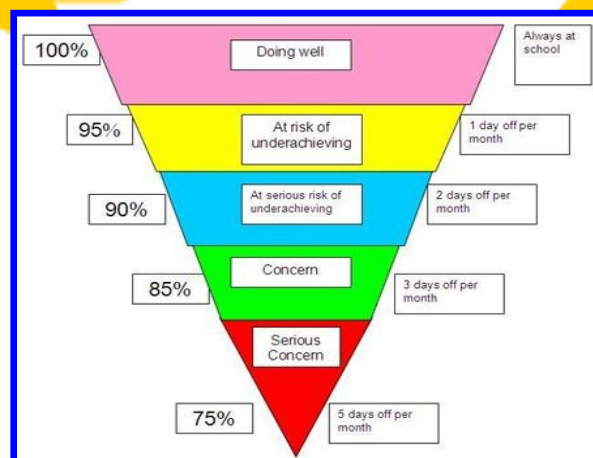
