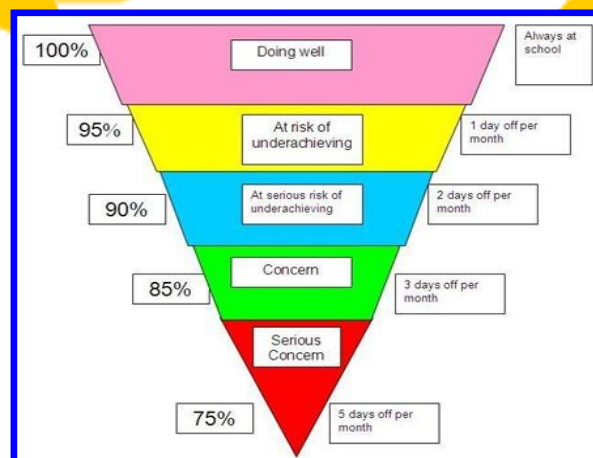

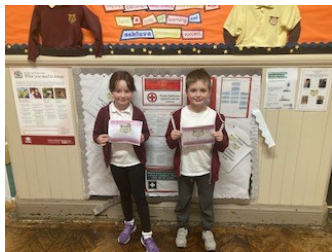
Salvation Army Penarth Toy Appeal

Last year the Eco Committee launched a new recycling project within Victoria Primary School.
