Dear Parents,

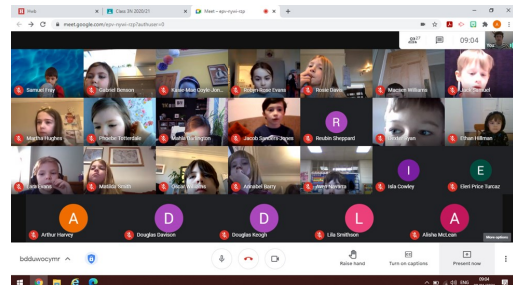

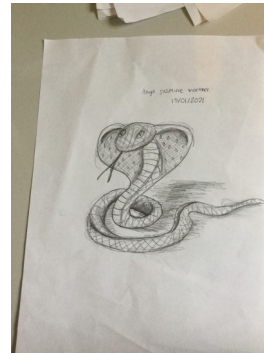
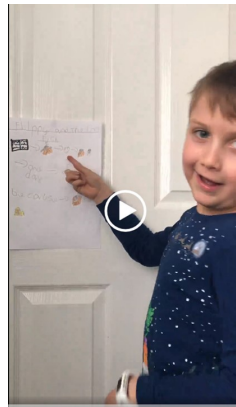
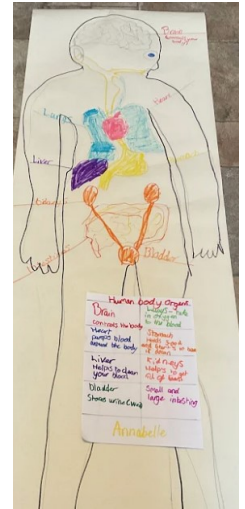
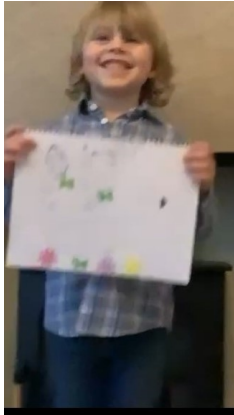
Happy 1st birthday Monty
