#### *What is Dydd Miwsig Cymru and why should you take part?*

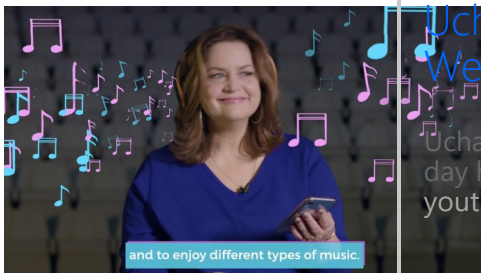
