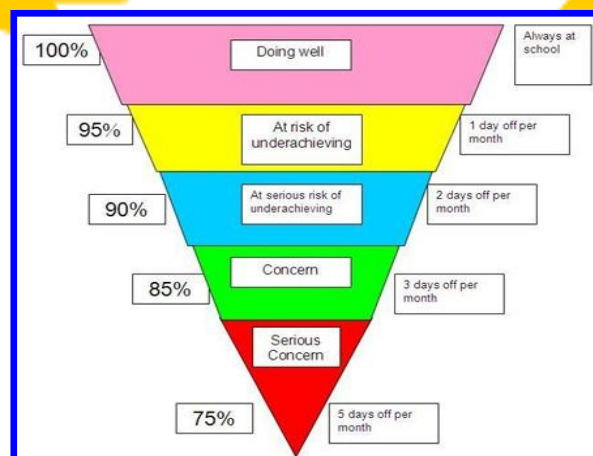

Sex and Relationships Education (SRE)

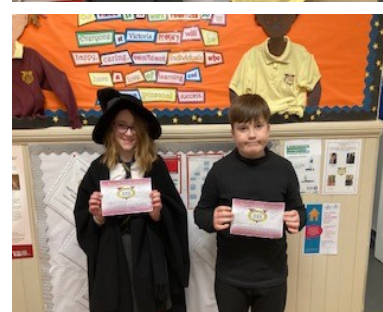
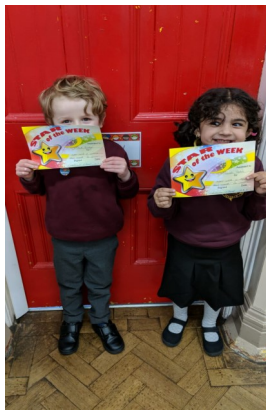
