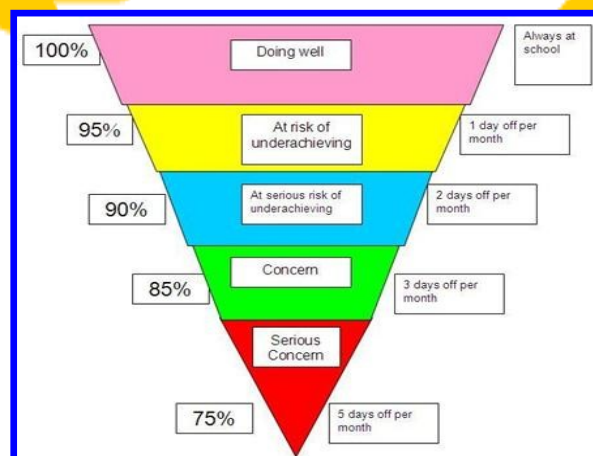

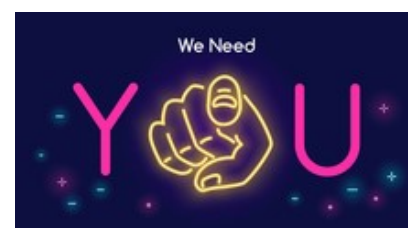
At the end of this term, our amazing PTA treasurer, Gareth Chalk, will be stepping down.
