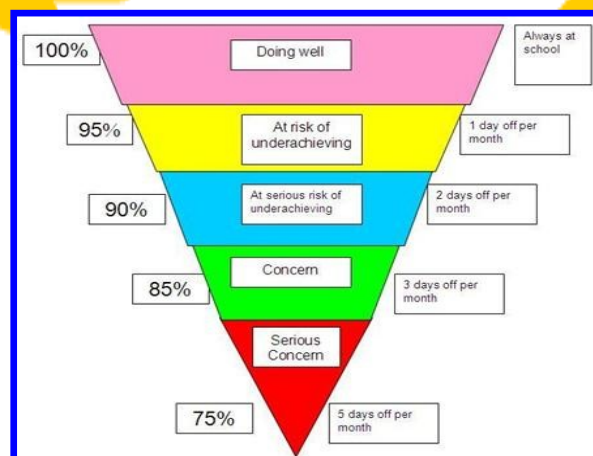

Road Safety

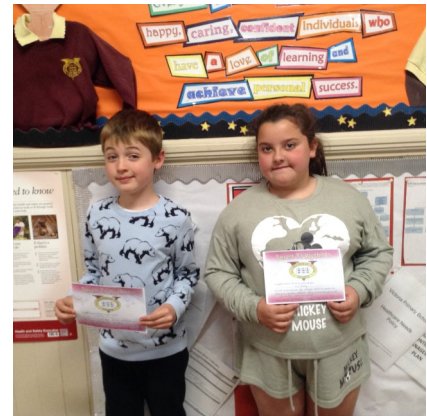
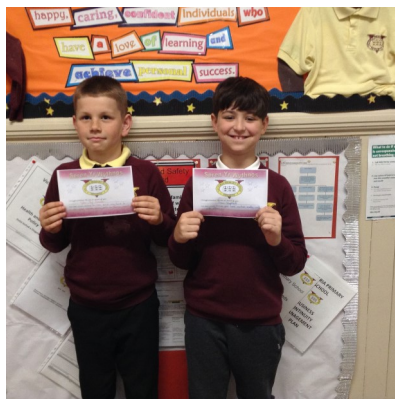
Please can I remind all parents and children to safely use the roads around the school. This week alone, two near misses have been reported due to carelessness of both pedestrians and car users.
