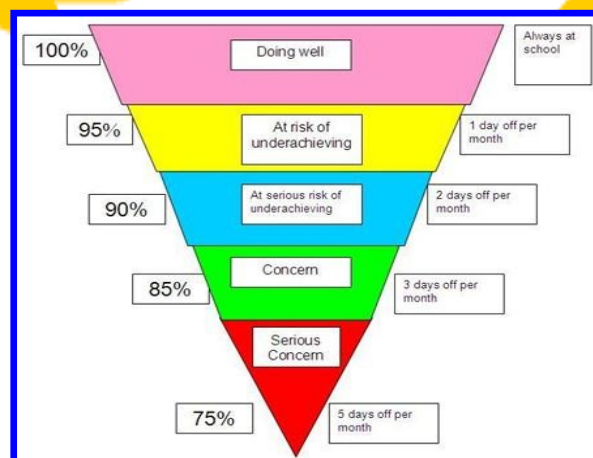

Salary: £9.50-£10.00 per hour

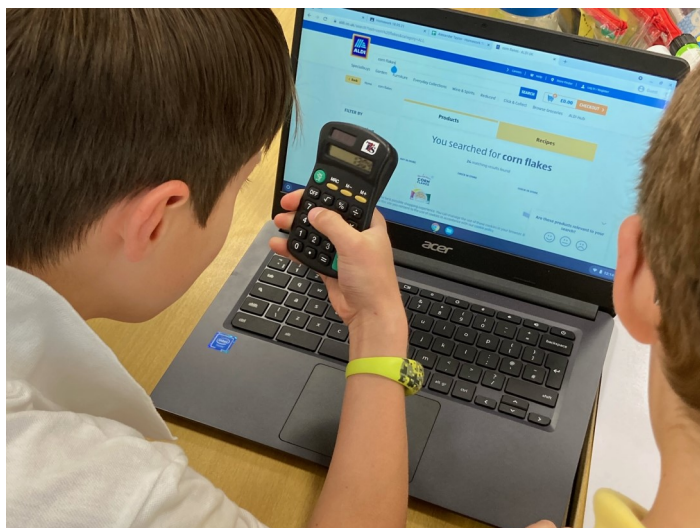
COVID-19 considerations:
