Dear Parents,

Thank you so much to all the parents of children Nursery - Year 5 who took time to complete the online questionnaire on the subject of PE kit. We received 300 responses, with a resounding 298 expressing the wish for children to wear PE kit to school on designated PE days. There were many reasons given such as:

- Less lost uniform;
- More hygienic;
- Less uniform required;
- Taking away the embarrassment of changing in front of others;
- More time given to actual PE activity.

As of September, children will wear a standard PE kit to school on their designated PE days. This will consist of plain black bottoms (skorts, shorts, leggings or jogging bottoms), round neck white t-shirt (with or without school logo) and a pair of trainers.

For the rest of this term, all children can continue to wear PE kit to school on PE days.

Google forms is proving a very good way of collecting parent views in an efficient way; we will certainly be using this on a more regular basis.

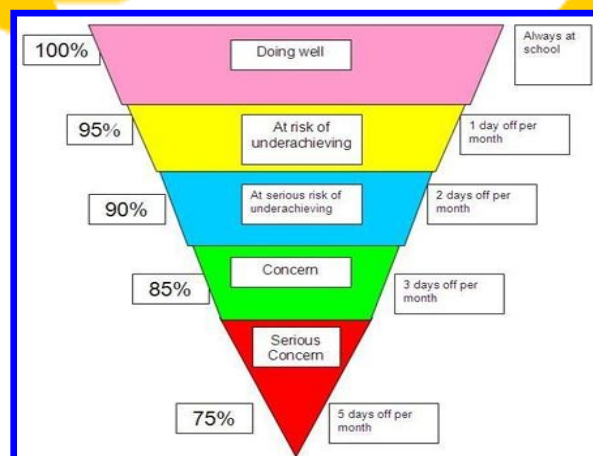

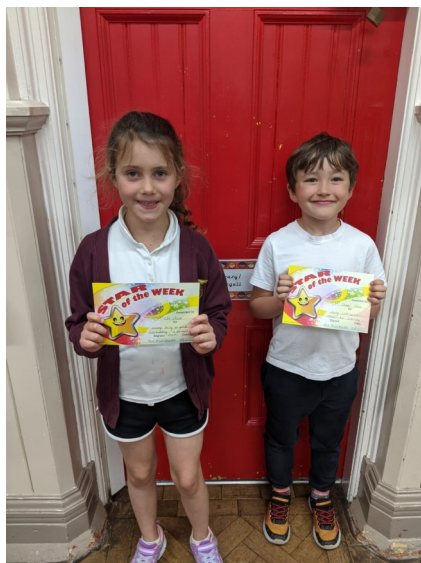
Environmental Day
