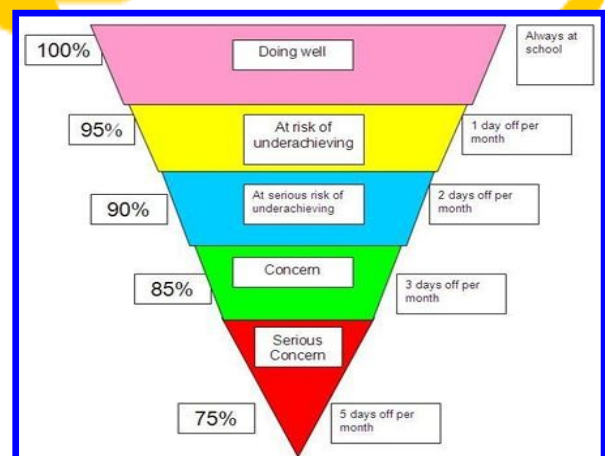

#### Sun safe

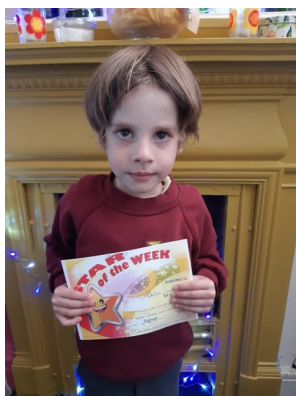
Next week, the weather forecast is predicting warm weather. It is imperative that the children are prepared for this eventuality. They will need sun cream applied before school, sun hats and water.

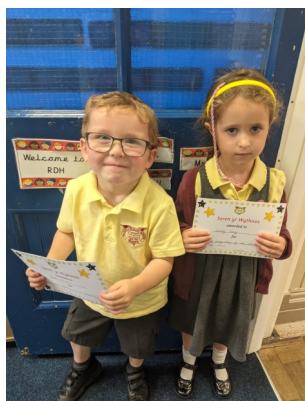
